




Remove saddle boards from doorways so wheelchairs can get around easily

Little adjustments to older people's houses can make a life-changing difference: making it possible for them to leave hospital and return home.

Martin and Patrick, two members of our Care + Repair team, explain how small fixes to houses can get people home from the hospital from Donegal to Cork.

“Every house is different. Every story is different. Recently, we put up two grab rails for a man who could no longer get into the shower after a stay in hospital. His wife wanted to get the bath taken out and changed to a walk-in shower. But she didn't have the money.

“We put a rail facing the shower head so her husband could hold on to it, and then one on the wall to help him in and out of the bath. So with two grab rails, it was like we regenerated the whole bathroom.

“You should have seen the look on her face when we had it done – she couldn't believe the difference it made.”
